COUNSFLOR-IN-TRAINING PROGRAM



JOB DESCRIPTION

The CIT leader's role is to design and implement the CIT curriculum and program. You also provide leadership and supervision to those in the CIT program as they learn and grow. You report directly to either the Assistant or Director of Tapawingo, depending on the day.

REQUIREMENTS

The following are preferred or required:

- At least 21 years of age or completed one year of college
- Agree to our Statement of Faith
- Holds a current CPR-FPR certificate and Wilderness First Aid certification (preferred) (We can help you obtain one.)

RESPONSIBILITIES

- Design and execute the program curriculum throughout the two CIT sessions in the summer.
- Fulfill leadership responsibilities such as aiding CIT's in their spiritual walk, goals, leading wilderness trips, Bible studies, and devotions according to the curriculum.
- Use leadership skills to daily guide the CIT participants and teach them how to function as a team.
- Become adept at wilderness skills, regulations, and safety procedures.
- Ensure the TAP CIT Program is in compliance with NYSDOH and Audit regulations at all times.
- Attend meetings with Camp Director/Assistant Director regarding performance and CIT updates.
- Create performance reviews at the end of each CIT session for the directors.
- Assist in communication with parent/guardian of the camper as directed by Tapawingo Director.
