JOB DESCRIPTION

Camp Counselors work alongside another counselor to provide leadership and supervision to a cabin of campers. They lead camper activities and contribute heavily to the joyful culture of camp.

REQUIREMENTS

The following are preferred or required:

- 18 years of age or completed one year of college
- Love for children and desire to grow, learn and lead
- Understanding and agreement of aims and philosophy of camp
- A Christian in agreement with our Statement of Faith
- Maintain physical health and dexterity for outdoor activities

RESPONSIBILITIES

- Work together with another co-counselor each week to guide a cabin of eight girls
- Provide leadership and guidance for girls in following areas:
 - Camp rules, policies and traditions
 - Camp activities, including badge program achievement
 - Spiritual life
 - Health and safety
 - Cabin and area cleaning procedures
 - Goal setting
- Make any necessary reports to Camp Director and Health Director regarding abuse of health, child abuse, and mental or emotional problems.
- Direct camper activity periods (such as crafts, canoeing, swimming, archery, climbing, sailing, and more).
- Create atmosphere of creativity, joy and fun for cabin.
- Engage encouragingly with other staff contributing to staff unity.
- Agree and comply with all policies, rules, standards and duties as outlined in Staff Guidelines.
- Assist in communication with parent/guardian of campers as directed.
- Attend weekly counselor meetings with Head Counselor.
