JOB DESCRIPTION

The Boat Crew members work under the Boat Captain to operate the marina and the boats for both COTW (CAMP-of-the-WOODS) and Tapawingo's needs.

REQUIREMENTS

The following are preferred or required:

- Must be at least 18 years old.
- Must have a passion for representing Christ as an employee of COTW
- Must obtain a New York State PV license (We help you obtain one.)
- Able to work a flexible schedule and have a good work ethic
- Commitment to the team culture where everyone is treated with honor, dignity, and respect
- Must have a servant's heart, keeping the needs of fellow team members and COTW members at the heart of your work

RESPONSIBILITIES

- Responsibly and safely rotate through five different duties throughout the week. These include:
 - Operating COTW's Marina
 - Transporting campers and staff on the ferry boat
 - Driving boat for camp guests/members during skiing and tubing
 - Driving the boat for Tapawingo skiing and banana boating
 - Making food deliveries from COTW's dining hall to Tapawingo
- Assist fellow crew members with daily tasks and maintain cleanliness, orderliness, and functionality of CAMP-of-the-WOODS Marina and all CAMP-owned boats.
